Hello Fellow Moose Members,

At the 2025 International Moose Convention in Milwaukee this past May, Moose International CEO Scott Hart announced a new [Fraternal Recognition Program](#) that is “open to every member – whether you just joined or have had your College of Regents Degree or Pilgrim Degree for 10 years, we all are starting at square one.” We recently heard more about the program at the Annual CNMA Convention in Sparks at the beginning of September.

There are four levels within the program – Preferred, Power, Prestige and Platinum.

The easiest way to learn more about this program is to go to the Moose International website (<https://www.mooseintl.org>), click on the “Already A Moose” button, scroll down to the “Moose Programs/Activities” box and click the “Fraternal Recognition Program” box. This will take you to a document that gives an overview of the entire program, including all four levels, but every member must achieve the first level in order to advance to others.

The main thrust of the program is to give all members recognition for the things they do for our Lodge. Do you bartend? Do you cook in the kitchen? Do you show up for workdays? Do you participate in events in our community that are initiated or sponsored by our Lodge? You now are able to get credit and recognition for your participation. And everyone starts the program as of May 1, 2025. I believe this information will also be posted on the bulletin board in the Lodge.

So, check it out. You may find that you have already completed a lot of the requirements for the first level of recognition.

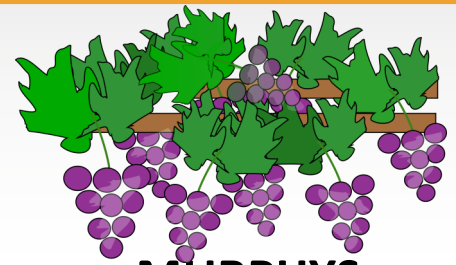

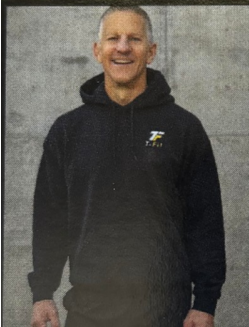

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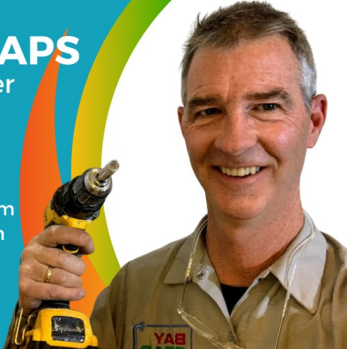
