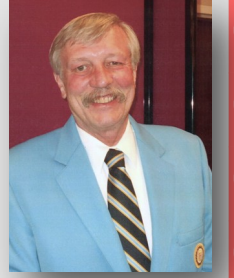

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Hello Fellow Moose Members,

Writing this, I am experiencing a bit of Déjà vu. I was Governor of this Lodge back in 2008. I went back through the Moose archives on my computer and found my first message, as Governor, for the May 2008 newsletter. Much of what I am going to express today are the same things I wrote 17 years ago.

First, I want to thank all the outgoing officers and committee chairs for their service to the Lodge over the past year. Everyone of these people give freely of their time with little thanks or appreciation for what they do. Many are stepping up to do it again in the coming year, and my thanks goes out doubly to them. I think we have a good group of people on the Board for the coming year and I look forward to working with them.

I also want to thank all the members who volunteer to cook, tend bar, maintain the building and all the other things that it takes to keep our Lodge open and operating. Without you, we would not be here at all. And it is important that we are here. The Moose is not just a place to come and have a drink, have a meal and socialize. We make a large contribution to our community. The money that is raised by our fund-raising events all goes back into our community, whether in the form of scholarships for graduating high school students, donations to school groups, donations to Hospice, or donations to other non-profit organizations in the community, Ebbetts Pass Moose raises a considerable amount of money every year for support of our community.

As the outgoing Governor said in the April 2008 newsletter, "Revenues are down, and costs are up". The same can be said today. This seems to be a constant refrain, not only in our Lodge, but also in all our lives and I know it's an issue that is hard to get a handle on. Over the past year the Board has taken a number of steps to raise revenue but was still unable to keep up with the rising costs. Our biggest issue being the extreme increase in the cost of our fire insurance. We will be addressing this issue further as this year goes on so that we don't have to take funds from our reserve account to cover the cost of fire insurance. One of the biggest ways we can increase revenue is to increase the number of events and dinners. To do this, we need the help of you, the members of Ebbetts Pass Moose Lodge 1123.

Our lodge runs on volunteers and the more volunteers we have the more events we can put on. So not only do we need the members of this Lodge to attend these events we also need you to volunteer to help put them on. In the years that I have been involved with the Moose, I have had the opportunity to visit quite a few other Lodges. I have found that the prosperous and successful Lodges have some kind of meal or event going on almost every day of the week. This Lodge at one time had Taco Night every Thursday. To do that we need more people to participate. It can't be the same couple of dozen people doing the same thing all the time because they will eventually burn out and quit.

So enough of my rambling. I am looking forward to this year and I believe with everyone's help and participation we can continue to make our Lodge the success and contribution to the community that it has always been

The Moose Legion is known as the Degree of Service.

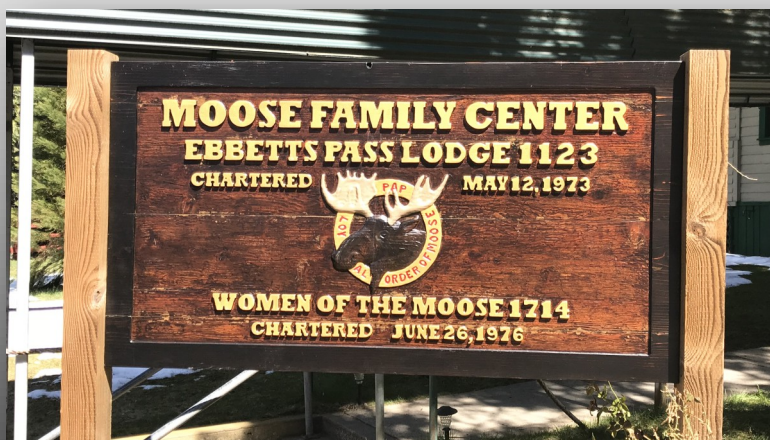
Our mission: To have fun while providing service to the Moose Fraternity.

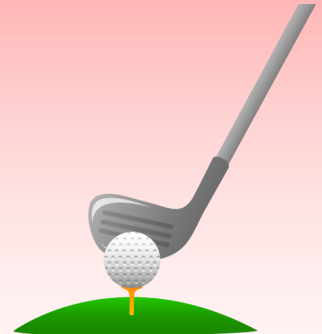
