

Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

I hope you have all noticed the improvements being made to the Game Room and Social Quarters this year. The building committee has been busy upgrading things for your enjoyment.

There are several new board games you'll find in the new cabinets, thanks to a generous donation. The bar stools in the game room have been reupholstered, and we are in the process of reupholstering the bar stools and table chairs in the Social Quarters.

We last sent a request for donations in November 2019. With those monies collected we were able to install a generator to keep the lodge running during power outages. We also made repairs to the outside of the building and painted the entire building. And of course, one of the biggest projects was installing a new roof on our lodge last year, all thanks to generous donations made by our members.

At this time, Ebbetts Pass Moose and Women of the Moose board members are reaching out to our membership asking for help by donating toward funds to help pay for Fire Insurance. As you know our insurance increased last year from \$8000 to \$21,997.13. In addition, we've been planning to install a handicap bathroom and upgrade the women's bathroom, which we've needed for some time, as well as further upgrades to the Social Quarters.

A separate fundraising effort is also underway to upgrade the playground in our backyard. For those of you who aren't familiar with the lodge history, our building was built in the 1930's and was originally the Blagen Sawmill headquarters. The Moose Lodge started leasing the building in 1978. We are blessed to have such a unique and beautiful location. As stewards of the lodge, we want to make sure it is here for future generations to enjoy.

Any monetary donation to help us with the next phase of building improvements or funding of Fire Insurance would be greatly appreciated. You may also drop donations off in the mail slot of the Administrator's office in the lodge.


