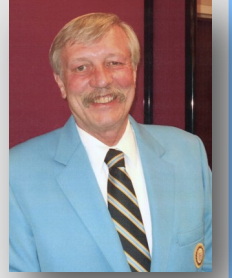

Administrator's Update



Summer is in Full Swing,

On July 23, we presented the Calaveras/Amador Hospice with a check for \$27,000. This represents the profits from the Dan Leary Memorial Golf Tournament. To EVERYONE who helped, give yourself a big pat on the back. It truly takes a village. Thank you, Kathy Ganley, for once again being the Chairman and master coordinator of this great event.

I want to again emphasize the importance of honoring your meal sign-ups. When members sign up but do not attend, it affects the lodge. For example, Paul's lamb dinner on Sunday made only \$2.18 because there were six no-shows, representing \$120 in lost revenue. Without those no-shows, the dinner would have earned \$122.18. Please consider the time and effort the crew puts into planning, shopping, cooking, and cleaning before signing up. A pattern of repeated no-shows has begun to develop among a few members. This topic will be on the agenda for the Board of Offices at the next meeting. We understand that things come up but if they do, please call the Lodge and tell the Bartender 24 hours in advance to help us with this issue.

Playground update: The new structure was loaded on a truck on July 24. Takes about 10 business days to get to us. Then the real fun begins assembling it. A call for volunteers will be made! The old wooden play structure has been taken down thanks to Chris Osincup so we are one step closer to completing this project. A special dedication ceremony will be scheduled honoring Pilgrim Bob Burns whose family made a substantial donation in his memory.

We have carpet & floor samples at the lodge and are in the process of picking the colors to replace the carpet and flooring in the Social Quarters. As we get closer to ripping up the old and installing the new carpet and flooring, please pay attention to the weekly updates and our communications board at the Lodge, as we will need to close the lodge for a short period of time.

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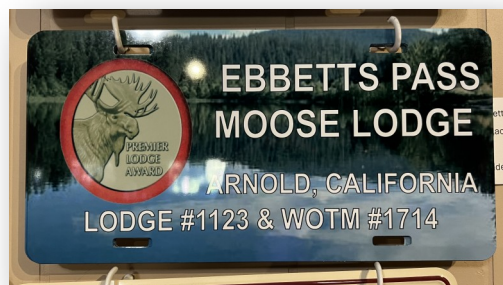
