Facing our upcoming annual fire insurance bill, your Board of Officers has been searching for ways to increase revenue and decrease operating costs. Not an easy prospect as all our operating costs, the cost of the products sold at the bar and the cost of the meals we service from the kitchen, along with utilities and just about everything else it takes to operate our Lodge continue to go up. At a recent Saturday round table meeting, the board discussed a number of ideas as to how we might accomplish these goals and concluded that since our main sources of the revenue necessary to operate our Lodge come from the bar and the kitchen, we didn't have much alternative but to raise our prices. Therefore, as of August 1st, drink and meal prices will increase by a dollar across the board.

We also looked at areas where we might cut costs. We are looking at the cost of keeping the lodge clean each month and hoping to reduce the scope of work of our cleaning service. To do this, we need to ask for volunteers to do some of the cleaning we now pay for and ask everyone to help keep the lodge tidied up daily. If something gets spilled on the floor, please clean it up. If the toilet paper is out, please replace it. Don't assume someone else will take care of it. Remember, our lodge operates on volunteers, not paid employees and all our members need to pitch in if we expect to continue to exist.

Hopefully our efforts to increase revenue and cut operating costs will get us over the hump in covering our annual fire insurance bill and the rest of our operating costs without dipping into our reserve account or seeking member donations.

If anyone has any other ideas as to how we can accomplish these goals, please don't hesitate to contact me or any of the other Lodge officers with your suggestions

NOTIFICATION OF PRICING CHANGES EFFECTIVE 1 AUGUST, 2025

Be sure to read the full details in our President's Message in this July 2025 Newsletter:

As we work to determine how we will afford the annual Fire Insurance for Ebbetts Pass Moose Lodge #1123, which are likely only to increase further over time, the Board of Officers has recently approved both cost cutting measures and revenue increases that will become <u>effective August 1, 2025</u>.

At that time, our members will see an increase in food and drink costs of \$1 across the board and Happy Hour will no longer be offered. We realize this will not be received positively by all of our members, but believe these changes will help to position us to avoid relying on our emergency reserve account or monetary donations from our members.

We request your understanding and trust that you will still find our prices favorable to outside businesses.




