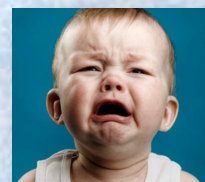

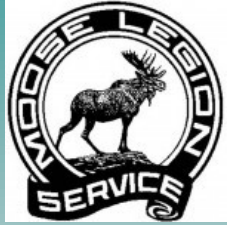

The Moose Legion is known as the Degree of Service.

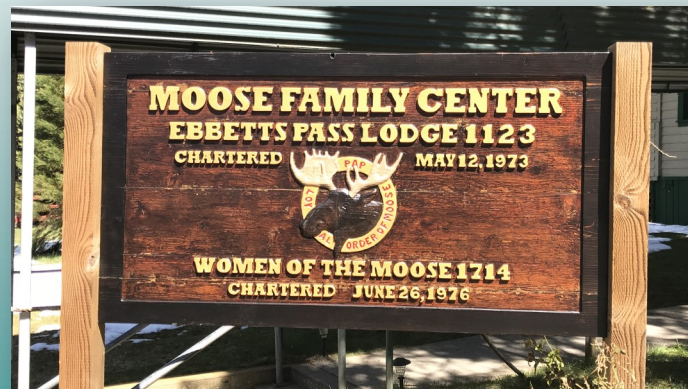

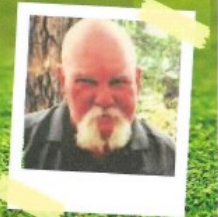

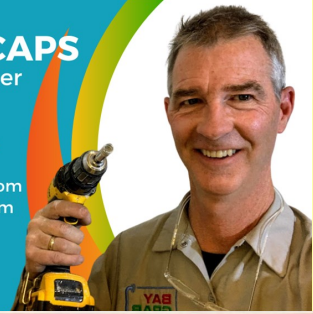
