Hearty of Community update. Moose International raised \$17,833,827.49 in donations and value of community service volunteer hours.

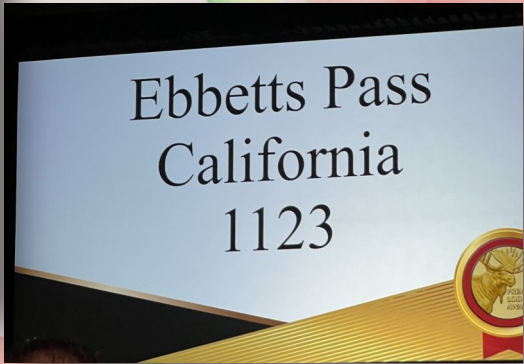

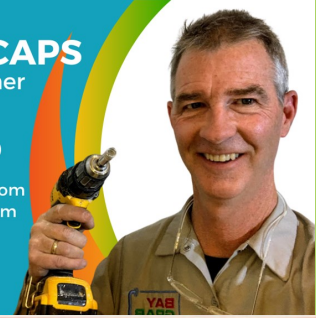
