6/29 Concert time with Jill and the Giants; this one's open to the public


Please come and show your support the family of Ray and Bob, and support the lodge at the district meeting.

BOB HARLOW: 1936-2024

Robert Lee Harlow (Bob) was born on October 9,1936 on to Violet and Quentin Harlow. He passed away on February 1, 2024, in Palm Springs California doing what he loved.

Bob spent his youth in Lincoln, graduating from Lincoln High School. In June 1955 Bob enlisted in the U.S. Navy. His career spanned more than 20 years during which time he served 7 tours of duty aboard the USS Mid-Way and USS Enterprise the first nuclear powered aircraft carrier in the U.S. Bob retired his military career as First Class Petty Officer.

Bob married Bernedia Lynch, and they had four beautiful children. Clifford, Linda, Bettie and Quentin. In 1975 Bob married Marilyn Avery; who he spent the last 48 years of his life with.

Bob was a 50-year member of the Ebbetts Pass Moose lodge, Elks lodge and VFW. Bob has been a Moose Member since 1972. He joined the Moose Legion in 2000, and earned is Blue Coat in 2008. Bob also served as our lodge Treasurer in 2007, and as Chairman for Audit, Community Service and Legion Committees. He's also been long committed to his community and active with many local organizations. Bob will be missed.

Bob is survived by his wife Marilyn of 48 years, Son Clifford Harlow (Margaret) Daughter Linda Harlow (Kathy), Daughter Bettie Harlow (Belinda), Son Quintin Harlow (Angel), his two brothers, Ray and Bill Harlow, his two sisters Ethel Zachgo and Margie McGee Loyd, his 7 grandchildren and 8 great-grandchildren.

RAYMOND SUTLIFF: 1927-2024





Raymond Sutliff November 28, 1927 ~ February 28, 2024 (age 96). Raymond "Ray" Leroy Sutliff, a longtime resident of Dorrington, CA, passed away on February 28, 2024 at the age of 96. He was born in Oakland, CA in 1927. Ray served as a cook in the U.S. Merchant Marines during World War II. He went on to work for the Boy Scouts of America with both the Los Angeles Council and the San Francisco Bay Area council, and retired after 50 years of service.

In 1989, Ray then moved from the bay area to Dorrington, CA with his wife Jackie. Many knew him as "Ray the Balloon Man," a business he started after moving to Dorrington. Ray was very involved in his community; he was a docent at Big Trees State Park and always an active member of Moose Lodge 1123 in Arnold, CA. He is preceded in death by his wife Jackie who passed away in 2002, and by a granddaughter who passed away in 2000. Ray is survived by his three children, Kathleen Everett (Olsen), Marlene Keven, and son Mark Sutliff; daughter-in-law Shelly; 5 grandchildren; and 6 great grandchildren.






