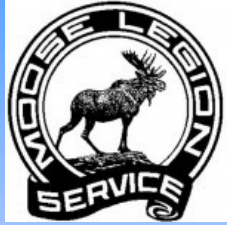

The Moose Legion is known as the Degree of Service.

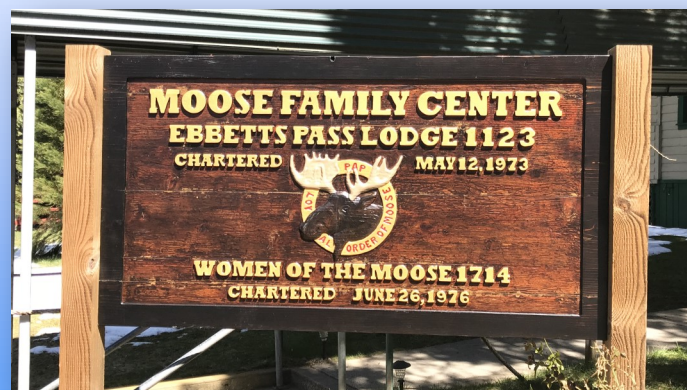

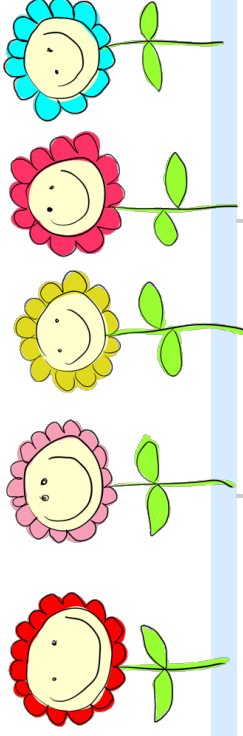

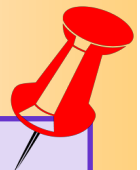


MEMBERS' MESSAGE BOARD

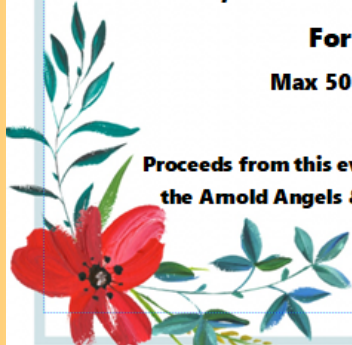

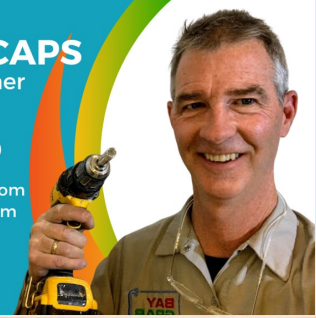
