# Administrator's Update



## What Powerful Winter Storm.....

Hopefully you all made it through the winter storm without too much damage. Talk about an impact to Arnold! But our Moose family truly came together. Many members reached out to other members to see if they needed anything from getting gas, driveways plowed, tree removal etc. It only took a call or text to ensure everyone was safe. It was a great showing of how much we cared and helped each other get through the last 8 days. Thank you for understanding that we decided to keep the Lodge closed for the weekend and wait until Monday, March 2 to reopen.

I want to thank everyone for making February's Crab Feed a big success. It was sold out at 90 guests. When we became One Moose Both the February & March Crab Feeds are combined—we no longer call it the men's vs. women's crab feeds. The meal, silent auction, raffle, 50/50, dessert auction and sales of appetizers get added up, and after all expenses are deducted, the profit goes 50% to the Lodge, 25% to the Moose Legion, and 25% to the Women of the Moose. Just a reminder that anything raised for a specific fund cannot be used for lodge bills. Next year we're looking at only selling 80 tickets per crab feed to ensure we aren't overly crowded. We have 11 tickets left for March – Don't miss out.

An update on the Playground fund; Megan & Chris Osincup have been working with different vendors to find the right equipment. We thought we had one, but the vendor was not a good business fit for us. We've since found a vendor with a better overall playground set up. But it is about \$5,000 more. The membership has raised a little over \$16,000 including a \$10K donation from Bob Burns' family. At the February Crab Feed we collected donations and raised another \$700. The star of the evening was Cece Osincup who personally walked the dining room and social quarters to collect donations. Thank you all for your generosity. Our goal is to get the playground ordered and installed this Spring/early Summer. With that said, once the playground equipment is delivered, we will need volunteers to help with assembly.

Hopefully Mother Nature will let us get through the rest of winter with milder weather. Already it's springlike again. We'll be back in the busy season again before we know it!






