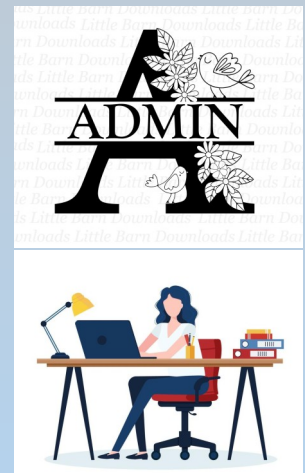


## Ebbetts Pass Moose Cookbook - 2nd Edition
