

Hand Embroidery Stitch Guide

Straight stitch:

Come up at (a), go down at (b), come up at (c), go down at (d), etc.




Backstitch:

Come up at (a), go down at (b), come up at (c).



Repeat by going down at (a), up at (d), down at (c), etc.




Stem stitch:

Come up at (a), go down at (b), come up at (c).




Repeat by going down at (d), up at (b), down at (e), etc.




Lazy Daisy:

Come up at (a), make a loop with the thread, go down at (a), and come up in the loop at (b)



Pull the loop to the desired shape, and go back down at (b) to secure the stitch.



French knot:

Come up at (a), wrap the thread around the needle bottom to top and pull tight.



Hold the thread taut, and go back down next to (but not directly through) (a)



Satin stitch:

Come up at (a), go down at (b), come up at (c), go down at (d), etc. to fill
