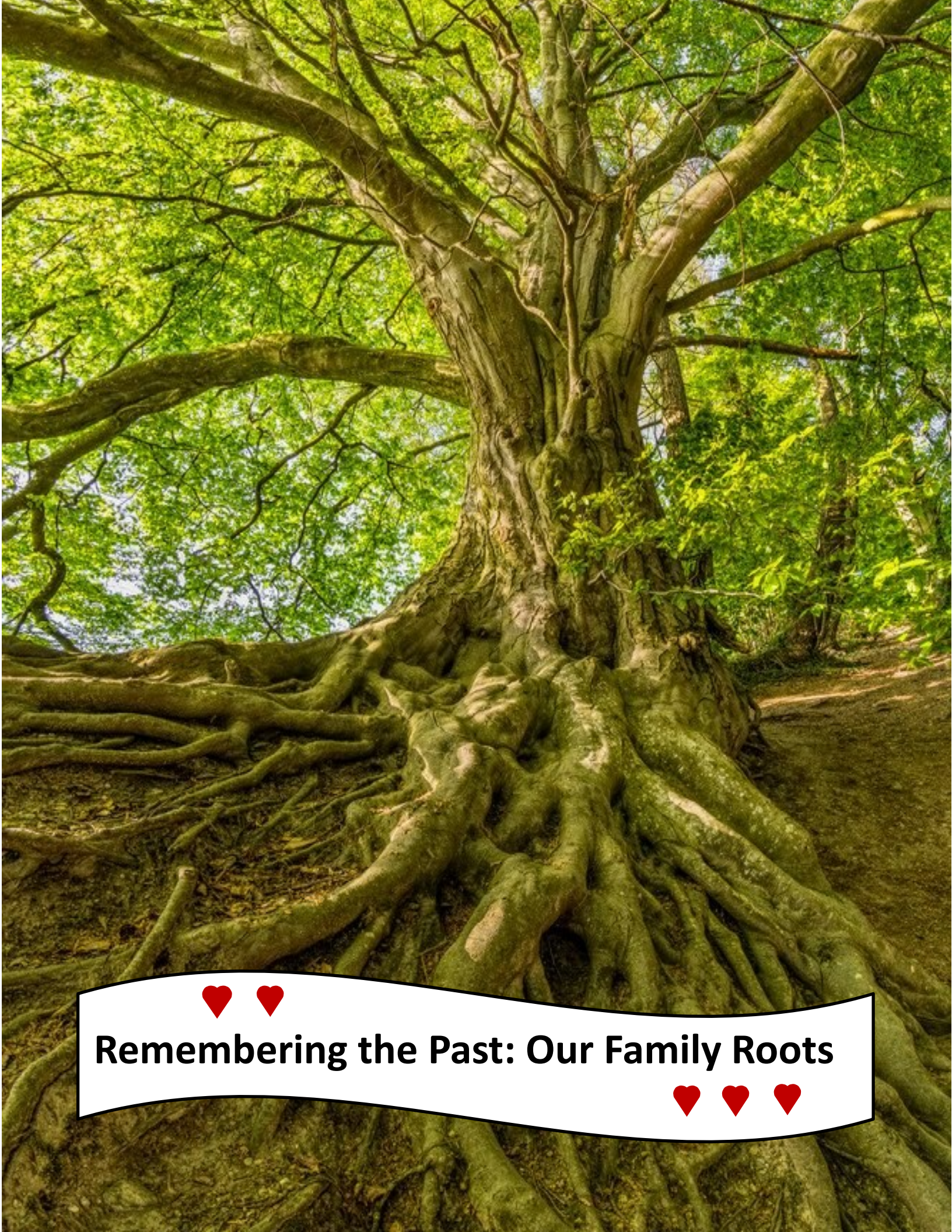

Remembering the Past: Our Family Roots





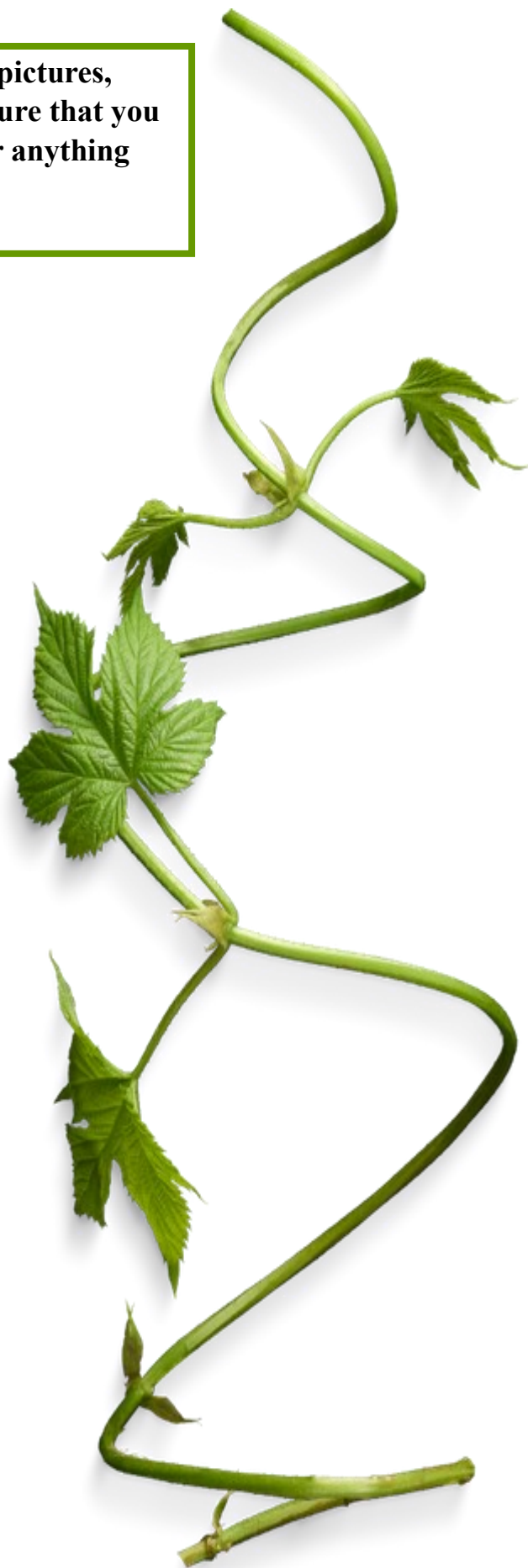
1. What is our family culture background?
