Please note: Students currently attending a Wellington Catholic Year 1 Kindergarten program are NOT REQUIRED to register for Year 2 Kindergarten. JUSTICE, PEACE AND THE INTEGRITY OF CREATION: The cardinal virtue of justice calls for the rights of all people to be respected, defended, and provided: it seeks the good of all people. Justice and mercy necessarily need to be seen as an indissoluble union of virtues for "justice without mercy is cruelty; mercy without justice is dissolution." (Thomas Aquinas). Finally, social justice is a virtue that guides human interaction and, in particular, the fair distribution of society's benefits, advantages, and assets, not just by law and in the courts but in all aspects of society.
