JUSTICE, PEACE AND THE INTEGRITY OF CREATION: In this time of great global uncertainty, Pope Leo began his address for the World Day of Peace with ““Peace be with you!” From the very evening of my election as Bishop of Rome, I have wanted to join my own greeting to this universal proclamation. And I would like to reiterate that this is the peace of the risen Christ – a peace that is unarmed and disarming, humble and persevering. It comes from God who loves us all

unconditionally.” (emphasis added) Imagine unarmed peace that is reached through dialogue and respect. It is the only way because peace cannot be imposed.


