The Inspired Art of Our Parish Title: The Acceptable Sacrifice Creator: Catherine M. Dillon OCA

Did you ever wonder about the meaning and inspiration behind the stained glass windows of our Church? The following excerpts are from the writings of the artist.

This piece was inspired by the martyrdom of St. René Goupil (First canonized Catholic Martyr in North America) and St. Isaac Jogues who both dedicated their lives, hearts, and his hands to the faith in their missionary work. These men suffered great torture and were killed for teaching and living the Catholic faith in Canada.

"You will note the simplicity of this window as I was so moved by this account that I etched the hands of God reaching down to accept the ultimate Sacrifice. The hands raised in full acceptance of their death are stumps, rather than hands. The red chalice is full of grace pouring out into the worthy vessels of Martyrdom. The Red Cross depicts the Martyrs' Vow: 'To die a Martyr for God and the Faith.' The yellow circle is the Glory Cloud of the Lord receiving the acceptable Sacrifice. The jewel in the heart of the Cross is the ultimate prize – life eternal with God and all His Saints for eternity. Do not be afraid of the Sign of the Cross. It is your identity in all that Jesus did for you."
