Calculating your monthly preauthorized giving

To help determine the amount of one's monthly contribution, multiply your weekly offering by the 52 weeks in a year, then divide this annual contribution by 12. Examples are provided below for your reference.

Weekly Offering \$10/week (\$520 for year) \$20/week (\$1040 for year) \$40/week (\$2080 for year) \$50/week (\$2600 for year) \$100/week (\$5200 for year)

Monthly Offering \$43 per month \$86 per month \$173 per month \$216 per month \$433 per month

Note that the amounts above are provided only for example. Our hope is that parishioners will contribute an offering that is meaningful, sacrificial, and that honors the abundance with which the Lord has blessed each of us.

How will preauthorized giving replace my current giving?

While your offering will be transferred electronically, the parish will continue to provide envelopes to those who enroll in preauthorized giving. These envelopes can still be placed into the collection as a sign of the preauthorized gift that you are giving to the parish. Please note that special collections (ie, Share Lent, Heritage Fund, etc.) still require that offerings be placed into special envelopes, and will not be processed through preauthorized giving.

What is preauthorized giving?

To accomplish the mission entrusted to us by Christ, St. John Brébeuf Parish depends entirely on the generosity of our community. Preauthorized giving allows you to give to your parish intentionally and faithfully through scheduled monthly transfers from your bank account. On or near the 20th day of each month, your account will be debited in amount you specify. These funds are then deposited directly into St. John Brébeuf church account.

How do I enroll?

First reflect on all that God has given you, and prayerfully decide how much of this you will return to God through your offering to St. John Brébeuf Parish. Then fill out the form on the other side of this brochure an attach a void check in the space provided. Place the completed form in a sealed envelope into the offertory collection, mail the completed form to the church, or drop it off in person.

- knowing that you continue to support the parish even when you are away



You may stop your preauthorized giving by simply writing a letter with 30 days notice to St. John Brébeuf Parish.
