NOVENA FOR THE SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION:

Once again, this year a Novena (*nine days*) of Masses leading to the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception will be held at the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate in Guelph. Novena Masses will be held at 7:30 each morning from November 30 to December 8, and will include the Novena Prayers, and a reflection on Our Lady in the life of Christ, and the life of the Church. On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, December 9 this year, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration at the Basilica following Morning Prayer at 8:30am, until Vespers and Benediction at 6:15pm. The Solemn Mass of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated at 7:00pm. As the Diocese's Shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Plenary Indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, for any of the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.
