AN ACT directing the commissioner of motor vehicles to conduct a study of official inspection stations, safety inspections and fees

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of motor vehicles shall conduct a study to examine and update the requirements of safety inspections conducted on motorcycles, gasoline, zero emissions and alternative fuel vehicles to ensure safety and reliability particularly as it relates to new technologies and to determine whether additional inspection items should be included. Such study shall also examine the sufficiency of the official inspection industry fees for state mandated motorcycle and vehicle safety inspections. Such study shall include consultation with representatives of official inspection stations, the National Highway Traffic 10 Safety Administration, and other relevant national vehicle safety organ-

§ 2. Upon completion of this study, but no later than 365 days next 13 succeeding the date on which this act shall have become a law, the commissioner of motor vehicles shall submit a report based on the findings of such study to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, the speaker of the assembly, the minority leader of the senate, 17 the minority leader of the assembly, the chair of the senate transporta-18 tion committee, and the chair of the assembly transportation committee which shall include, but not be limited to, the findings of the study as well as recommendations for statutory or regulatory changes.

§ 3. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 21 22 have become a law.
