

PUBLIC EMISSIONS INSPECTION STATION BUY/SELL AGREEMENT

Enclose this form with the Original Facility Application submitted by the purchaser

In order for DMV to accept for review a buy/sell agreement for an official public emissions group 1a inspection station, the selling facility and the purchasing facility must be in the same county or within five miles of each other. Additionally, the selling facility must be in "good standing" at the time of sale. "Good standing" means that:

- the facility license is valid and is not suspended or revoked,
- the facility does not owe any outstanding civil penalties,
- the facility has no hearings or appeals pending before the DMV, and
- the facility has no litigation pending in which the DMV is named as a party.

The selling facility must also be able to account for all unused inspection certificates (stickers). If inspection certificates are missing, there may be long delays in processing the buy/sell agreement, denial of the application, or possible administrative action.
