Good to Know at Poskin Lake

- **No-wake hours:** 6:00 p.m. – 10:00 a.m. (please inform guests)
- **Weed management:** Property owners may manage **30 feet of shoreline**
 - Pull or rake weeds, let them dry, and dispose properly
 - Do not allow cut weeds or grass into the lake
- **Curly Leaf Pond Weed** is present—please help prevent its spread
- **Fishing limits** are posted at the landing and online
