- Garment Bags
- Garment rack (optional)
- All costumes, labeled with your child's information
- All Costume Accessories
- Tights (2+ pairs)
- Shoes
 - Ballet
 - Tap
 - Jazz
 - Lyrical
- Make-Up
 - Foundation (optional)
 - Blush
 - Powder (optional)
 - Eye shadow
 - Eye liner (optional)
 - Mascara
 - Lipstick
 - Make-Up Wipes
- Hair
 - Hairspray – Firm Hold
 - Ponytail Holders (choose a color to match your dancer's hair)
 - Bobby Pins (choose a color to match your dancer's hair)
 - Brush
 - Comb
- Emergency Items
 - Safety Pins
 - Needle & Thread or Liquid Stitch
 - Baby Wipes/Wet-Ones
 - Static Guard

Recommended Items

- Sheet or Blanket to sit on (or used for changing)
- Lint Roller/masking tape
- Tide Stick
- Mirror
- First Aid Supplies
- Snacks/Sack Lunch (NON MESSY)
- Water bottle
- Activities (NON MESSY – no markers, glitter, glue, etc)

Leave all jewelry and valuables at home!

Tips and Suggestions

- 1) Label everything! (costumes, tights, shoes, totes, belongings)
- 2) Create a checklist of everything you need to bring (or use the one provided).
- 3) Check the schedules before each day of rehearsal and performances to make sure you don't miss anything!
- 4) Arrive early! Give yourself plenty of time to get settled into the dressing room.
- 5) Bring some activities, water and snacks for your dancer during recital.
- 6) Make sure students are well-rested – naps are a good idea, even for older dancers.
- 7) Make-up tips – please use colors outlined in handbook.
- 8) Hair tips – hair should be in a bun with no fly-aways. Use a lot of firm hold hair-spray, use plenty of bobby pins, hair nets are a plus.
- 9) Relax and HAVE FUN! Don't lose sight of our end goal; recital is a celebration! Enjoy every minute.
