

Dear Senator Parker,

I'm a Flower Mound parent in your district, and I'm reaching out because Lewisville ISD is moving forward with relocating its Disciplinary Alternative Education Program (DAEP) to **multiple regular campuses**—specifically Old Settlers Elementary, Valley Ridge Elementary, and possibly others like Hedrick Middle or Huffines Middle (per recent board agendas and parent reports). This isn't just a one-site shift; it's scattering high-risk students across elementary and middle schools with no clear separation plan.

Texas Education Code §37.008 requires DAEPs to be "safe and appropriate" and in settings separate from regular classrooms. But these proposals mean:

- Kindergarten through fifth graders at Old Settlers and Valley Ridge will share hallways, playgrounds, and drop-off zones with kids who've committed violent offenses, threats, or weapons violations.
- Middle school sites like Hedrick or Huffines could mix DAEP students with 6th–8th graders during transitions—no fences, no locked buffers, just 50–100 feet of shared space.

We've got real incidents: our DAEP has documented fights, bullying escalations, and even weapons seizures in recent years (available via public records). Colocating like this isn't "appropriate"—it's creating foreseeable danger.

Uvalde still weighs heavy. Salvador Ramos racked up suspensions for fighting, harassment, and threats—but stayed in mainstream classes until tragedy hit. No DAEP ever. The lesson? When at-risk kids aren't properly isolated, red flags get missed, and lives are lost. This multi-campus plan risks the same: weaker oversight, longer exposure across sites, and one preventable incident away from heartbreak.

Parents are mobilizing—over 150 signatures on [keeposesafe.com](https://www.keeposesafe.com), and we're ready to bring maps, and testimonies to Austin if needed. But we need your voice. Could you:

1. Advocate for a bill in the next session requiring **separate DAEP sites** for elementary or middle campuses?
2. Request a TEA safety review of this multi-site relocation under §37.008?

I'm happy to send visuals, board minutes, or connect you with other families. This isn't about politics—it's about protecting our kids before it's too late. A quick call or reply would mean a lot.
