What you can do with Google Voice



- Easily call people in your contacts
- Text using your new number from any device
- Save time by reading your voicemail in your email inbox
- Get protected from spam calls, block unwanted callers, and screen calls
- *To offer these services, Voice saves and processes your call, text, and voicemail information.


Sign up for Voice and get your number (Computer)



1. On your computer, go to voice.google.com
2. Sign in to a personal Google Account.
3. After reviewing the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, tap Continue.
4. Search by city or area code for a number. Voice does not offer 1-800 numbers. If there are not any numbers available in the area you want, try somewhere nearby.
5. Next to the number you want, click Select. Follow the instructions.

Sign up for Google Voice and get your number (Smartphone)



1. On your smartphone device, download the Google Voice app.
2. Open the Voice app. 
3. Sign in to a personal Google Account.
4. After reviewing the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy, tap Continue.
5. To pick your Voice number, tap Search. You can search by city or area code for a number. Voice does not offer 1-800 numbers. If there are not any numbers available in the area you want, try somewhere nearby.
6. Next to the number you want, click Select. Follow the instructions.
