Membership Enrollment and Agreement

ADULT STUDENT CLAUSE:

This Agreement, dated the _____ day of _____, 2026 is made between Synergy Equine and _____ (STUDENT). These parties warrant that they have the right to enter into this AGREEMENT.

MINOR STUDENT CLAUSE:

I, _____, (Parent/Gaurdian) have contracted with Synergy Equine on the _____ day of _____, 2026 to give _____ (Rider's name) riding lessons. These parties warrant that they have the right to enter into this AGREEMENT.

It is hereby agreed that: The STUDENT wishes to enroll for riding lessons at SYNERGY EQUINE under the following conditions.

1) TERM:

A Synergy Membership includes **FOUR** lessons a month on a provided lesson horse. Membership terms last **SIX MONTHS**. Lessons can be scheduled via text (801-362-0448) or through Synergy Equine's online booking system (<https://synergyequineidaho.com/riding>). To be eligible for a Synergy Membership, you must first complete at least one horse-provided lesson.

The initial term shall commence on the **1st** day of _____, 2026, and will end on the **1st** day of _____, 2026.

This agreement is binding and will automatically renew on a month to month basis unless notice is given by either party at least thirty days before the initial term ends.

2) PAYMENT: (Please Check One)

- I will pay for my (or my minor child's) riding membership in FULL at the beginning of the 6 month term for **\$1100**. I understand that if I terminate my membership before the full term is up, I will not be reimbursed or refunded for any remaining lessons.
- I will pay for my (or my minor child's) riding membership on a monthly basis for **\$200/month**. Monthly fees will be **due on the 1st of the month**. In case of late payment, all riding lessons for this student will be suspended until payment is made in full. No credit will be given for lessons missed due to suspension.

Acceptable forms of payment include cash, check, and venmo (synergy-equine-78).

3) ABSENCES AND RESCHEDULING

- a. In the event of your lesson coinciding with poor weather, such as rain and where riding conditions are considered unsafe, you will have the option of attending an unmounted lesson during your lesson time, or rescheduling to a different day. Unmounted lessons are a great way to improve overall horsemanship and knowledge, as well as help a rider progress to potentially owning or leasing their own horse. A variety of

topics may be covered such as general horse care, in depth grooming, vaccines and deworming, equine anatomy, feeding and nutrition, groundwork, etc. If you opt to reschedule, those lessons must be made up before the last day of the month or that credit will be considered void.

***NOTE* During the months of December-March when weather is especially unpredictable, any lessons canceled due to weather can roll over into the next month as a lesson credit if reschedules or unmounted lessons are not possible before the end of the month.**

- b. In the event that the STUDENT needs to reschedule a lesson for any reason not including weather such as illness or in an emergency, it is at the discretion of the Riding Instructor and their availability. We will make all attempts possible to try to reschedule, but if we are unable to before the last day of the month, that lesson credit will be considered void.
- c. In the event that SYNERGY EQUINE needs to reschedule a lesson for any reason such as illness or in an emergency, we will make all attempts possible to reschedule. If we are unable to before the last day of the month, that lesson credit will roll over into the next month.
- d. Riders must contact the riding instructor 24 hours before the start of their scheduled lesson to cancel. If you do not contact us to cancel the lesson, you will not be permitted to make up the lesson and it will be deemed as taken.
- e. In the event of an emergency or sickness, please call to cancel the riding lesson as soon as you are aware that you will not be able to attend the lesson but no later than 2 hours prior to your lesson time.

4) PUNCTUALITY

- a. I understand that lesson times are planned and that I need to be on time.
- b. If I am more than 15 minutes late from my scheduled time, I will not be permitted to participate in the lesson and it will be considered taken (unable to reschedule) unless I have made prior arrangements.
- c. I further understand that even if I am late, the time for ending the lesson will remain as scheduled.
- d. The only condition for extending my lesson time is if the Riding Instructor is not present at the scheduled lesson time.

5) LESSON POLICY STANDARD

- a. Lessons taken through a Synergy Membership are individualized, private, and one hour long. Occasionally lessons may go fifteen to thirty minutes longer at instructor's discretion.
- b. A lesson is to consist of grooming, tacking up, mounting, tack adjustments, exercises while mounted, cool down time, dismounting, and untacking.
- c. We feel that it is very important not just to teach riding but to also teach safety, proper grooming techniques, horse handling, and how to properly tack your horse. Beginner students may be required to spend extra time working on these techniques and less time riding.
- d. The Riding Instructor additionally has the responsibility of safety for riders, volunteers, and horses at all times; therefore, the Instructor has the right to deviate from the above lesson outline when safety is a concern.

I have read this document and understand and agree with its premises. I further understand that if any of the above policies or rules are violated, Synergy Equine has the right to terminate my membership effective immediately without any refund of money.
