A **VEOC Action Message Form** (triplicate) is filled out for each call detailing the specific incident. Do not stack forms on top of each other while writing on them as they will transfer through to the other forms. Please print clearly.

- 1. Make sure you get the following information on the VEOC form:
  - a. Name of Sector Chief, Sector #, and Village
  - b. Address of where incident is occurring.
  - c. **Type of incident**: e.g., fire, gas leak, down tree, etc.

(Write **Action Message Form** # and address of incident on **Radio Log Form**)

 Verify by repeating the information back to the Sector Chief, you will assess the form and determine which Specialty Team should receive the form. If you are unsure which Specialty Team should respond to the incident, you should consult with the Communications Director.

- 3. Give the <u>entire Action Message Form</u> to the **Message Form Runner**. The **Communications Director** will inform you of who the **Runner(s)** is/are. Raise the red flag if a runner is not readily available.
  - a. The **Runner** will give the top 2 copies (white & yellow) to the assigned **Specialty Team**.
  - b. The **Runner** will give the bottom copy (pink) to the **Incident Commander** desk.
- **4.** The **Incident Commander** will determine when the Stand-Down order is appropriate, indicating that the emergency is over. At that time, you will proceed to the **shutdown process** on the next page.

## **SHUTDOWN PROCESS:**
