

# SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION OF GREENSBURG

## REGULATED HUNTING GROUND RULES

These rules are in conjunction with the current Pennsylvania Game and Wildlife Regulations:

1. Season- September 1 through March 31. Members Only. **NO GUESTS.** Junior members 12 to 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult family member or by an adult serving in place of a parent (adult member for SAG's rules is an active or life member). All other junior members must be with an active or life member.
2. The boundary of the premises covered by this permit as regulated hunting grounds shall be marked in such a manner that any intruder is warned of the purpose of the area and that is unlawful to enter.
3. Must have current PA hunting license.
4. Must display vehicle pass.
5. Must wear 250 sq. inches of fluorescent orange at all times, head, back, and shoulders.
6. Two (2) pheasants per day, twenty-eight (28) pheasants per season per member. Five quail (5) per day, three (3) chukar per day, no season limit
7. Any pheasants taken over the season limit, replace the pheasant through the game committee.
8. All stocking times and dates will be posted on the stocking schedule. Hunting Times after all stockings will be as marked on the schedule. Hunting on all other days as regulated by PGC, except that **Sunday hunting shall begin at 9:00 am.**
9. **ALL GAME BIRDS MUST BE SIGNED AND TAGGED.** (On the right leg) on the day the bird was harvested, tags and sign-in sheets are at the lower farm house. Use tags in numerical order. **CHUKARS ARE NOT GAME BIRDS. DON'T USE LEG TAGS, BUT THEY MUST BE SIGNED IN.**
10. Right leg tag must remain on bird until it is prepared for consumption.
11. Individuals may stock and hunt their own birds. **All birds must be recorded and tagged.** You must leave your receipt for payment of the birds with the club register at the farm house. The daily bag limits do not apply to privately purchased birds. No private stockings on days when the club stocks or on any day for which the club has stocked the previous afternoon/ evening. Privately stocked birds may only be harvested on the day that they are stocked. Any unharvested birds become club property.
12. No small game hunting during rifled deer hunting season.
13. Dogs may be trained in accordance with **PGC** regulations. No Dog training/ hunting after the afternoon/evening stockings until the following morning.
14. **NO LITTERING, PICK UP ALL EMPTY SHELLS AND GARBAGE.**
15. No field dressing of any game in parking areas, along roads or trails, in camping or picnic areas, around buildings or on any range.
16. **ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS.** Do not block the access gates!  
The Designated Parking Areas are: 1. Upper Field Gates 2. Middle Fields Parking Lot 3. Farmhouse Lot.  
4. Archery Range Lot 5. Trap house Lot 6. Retention Pond Gate 7. Back Gate/ Brinker Rd.

## ***ODD/ EVEN HUNTS***

The Odd/ even format that has been used in past years will be utilized for the 2022/23 season for varied hunts specified on the Stocking Schedule.

All members will hunt on the day scheduled based on their EVEN or ODD club number: there could be exceptions. **EXAMPLE:**

All members with Even club numbers are scheduled on Sat. 12-20-22

All members with ODD club numbers are scheduled on Sun 12-21-22

Hunting times will be as follows on Saturday 12-20-22:

All EVEN club members will hunt first from 9:30 to finish.

All ODD club members will hunt from 12:00 pm to finish.

Hunting times will be as follows on Sunday 12-21-22:

All ODD club members will hunt first from 9:30 am to finish.

All Even club members will hunt from 12:00 pm to finish.
