TREE STAND POLICY

Members of the Sportsman's Association of Greensburg may erect Treestands on Club property to be utilized for hunting purposes. The following is a list of guidelines that is expected be followed:

- 1. Stands may be erected no sooner than 2 weeks before the opening of Archery Deer Season.**
- 2. Stands shall be marked in an easily identifiable manner with your club number. This is done so that we can recognize if non-members of the club are utilizing our property. Climbing/ Ascending type treestands need not be marked for in day use, however if left affixed to the tree then such stands shall be marked also.**
- 3. Stands not marked shall have a notice affixed. After a period of no shorter than 7 days if the stand in question is not properly marked or removed it can be removed. Once a stand is removed it shall become club property.**
- 4. Treestands are to be removed at the end of hunting season. Deadline for removal is March 31st. Stands on the property after the aforementioned date (marked or otherwise) are subject to removal.**
- 5. A member owning a stand in violation of any portion of this policy shall be suspended from the club for the period of October 1st to March 31st of the same year of the violation.**
- 6. Stands erected for use are the sole responsibility of the owner. The club will not be liable for any accidents, injuries, or tragedies resultant of their use. The use of proper safety equipment; i.e.: safety harnesses, ascending/ descending equipment, is mandatory. The owner of a treestand shall also not be held liable for any accidents by others utilizing their stand.**
