



## Code of conduct to Coaches

### Guidelines for Coaches

- To arrive at training sessions and match venues at least 45minutes before start time.
- Wear full coaching attire to all games and training sessions. If coaching attire is lost or damaged, you will be required to purchase a new one.
- To adopt the 3 seconds rule at all matches and training sessions. (Refer to Brent United's playing style and philosophy).
- To place the wellbeing and safety of each player above other considerations including the development of performance.
- Encourage all players and help them reach their own full potential.
- Encourage participation for fun and community spirit, not just winning.
- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, and spectators.
- Adhere to the laws and spirit of the game. To adhere to the guidelines laid down within the Constitution and Rules of the Football Association.
- Promote Fair Play and high standards of behaviour.

- Be fair, considerate and honest with all players.
- Maintain a current DBS check
- To consistently display high standards of behaviour and be a role model for players, parents and spectators.
