

ease). In the evening there was a musical group for our entertainment as we learned about musical therapy for children at the Medical Center. Children who are scared, upset or afraid are treated by a trained musical therapist to assist in helping to relieve their anxiety. Music helps the children relax and ease their apprehension. In the lobby we were able to watch a ballot troupe entertain the

children and parents. A staff lady brought a therapy miniature horse for children to pet. The staff does a marvelous job in taking care of their patients.

While in the Los Angeles area we were able to visit the Shrine Auditorium and their Shrine Museum which included a Daughters of the Nile exhibit. One exhibit is a quilt made for PSQ Sharalyn Wininger by her Egyptian Maidens, we found the square PQ Joan Sterns had added to the quilt.
