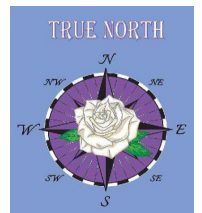


Naphis Temple No. 66 meets on the fourth Monday of January, February, March, April, May, June, September, October, and November at 7:00 p.m.

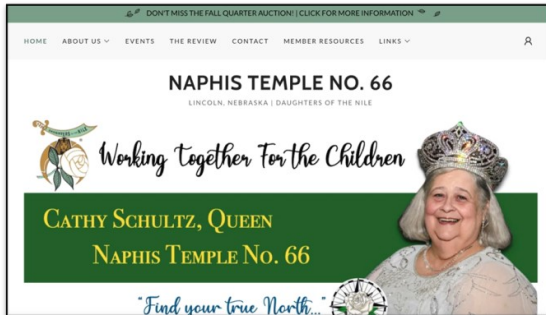

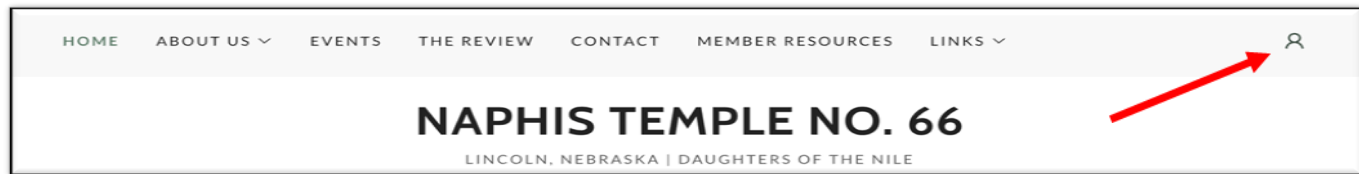

sion next June in Texas! I am thrilled to see everyone in person once again after such a long absence.

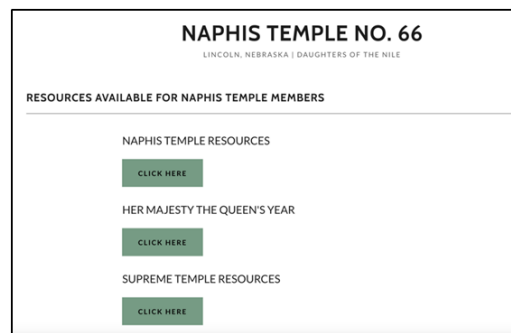
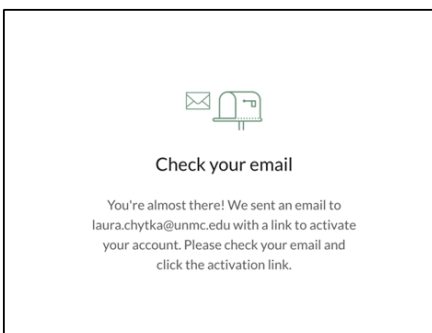
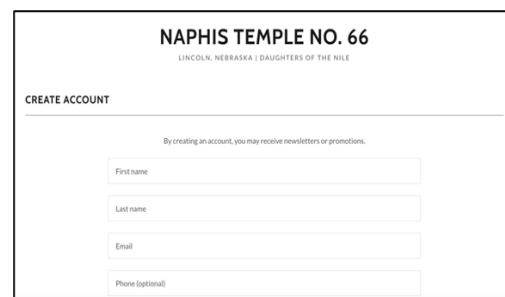
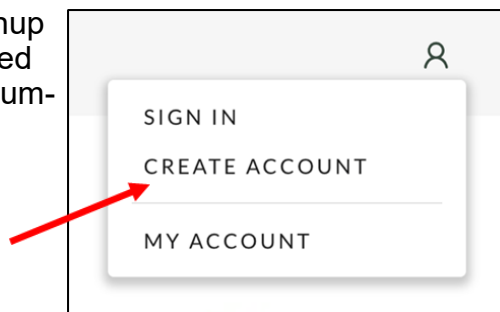
