
to see her at the soup supper. She will be missed by many, but I'm sure she is wearing her high heels and black hose again in Heaven, and dancing up a storm.



lofty goals and are anxious to move forward. Check your new roster for officers and members of this new Unit and for any questions to join this special group of ladies!



PQ Evelyn Rauch passed away Christmas Evening, December 24, 2021.


