E-WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES

E-Waste is any consumer electronic equipment that has reached its 'end-of-life' or 'end-of-usage,' whether in full or non-working condition. It includes most electronics or electric appliances with a cord or circuit board such as:

Computers & Devices:

Monifors PC Systems Laptops Networking Equipment Scanners Copiers Printers Main Frame Units Toner Cartridge Mother Board Systems

Electronics:

Television Sets Home Entertainment Systems VCR/VCD/DVD Players Fax Machines Landline and Cellular Phones UPS & PDAs Power Supplies Small Portable Devices

We also accept Car and Forklift Batteries We do not accept: Fluorescent Light Bulbs and Household Batteries There is a service charge for Major Appliances including: Microwave Ovens, A/C & Cooling Units

BULKY ITEM COLLECTION GUIDELINES

Buky items are items that are generally considered to be too large to fit in your residential or multifamily trash container. They are items that are unwanted, passed their useful life, broken, in need of repair, or simply old, worn out, and not wanted. The following are examples of items that can be placed in the bulky items collection containers.

- ·Mattresses
- ·Box Springs
- ·Beds
- ·Bedframes
- ·Sofa, chairs, and recliners
- ·Tables, nightstands, and furniture

- ·Cabinets and other furniture
- ·Doors
- ·Large play equipment ·Lawn furniture

The following items are NOT allowed for bulky item collection:

- Appliances
- ·Hazardous waste
- ·Incendiaries
- ·White goods (refrigerators, washers, etc.)
- ·Air conditioners
- ·Yard waste
- ·Trees, leaves, branches, bushes, and grass

- ·Electronics
- ·Batteries
- ·Paint and stains
- Ammunitions
- ·Animal carcasses
- ·Recyclables

No commercial dumping permitted.
