It is with great pleasure that I write this letter of recommendation on behalf of Gargi Barooah. I have known Gargi for just about one year. My daughter (6) took piano lessons with Gargi beginning of last October. It was the first time she ever got piano lessons and she was not able to read any notes at that time.
