Lisa Ellis - Charming cathedral windows Cost \$45



The information will be attached. The first block will be the Ruby block and will be due in February. The fabric requirement is for 2 blocks the same. There are only 6 different blocks, but you will make 2 at a time. You only need to bring one to the February meeting to qualify for the drawing.

FYI: Fabrics Etc has several ombre fabric choices that might be of interest to you for this quilt.

I hope you will enjoy working on this quilt. It should come together quickly.
