Scott and I used these 10 questions every time we hosted a Kid's Club. We wanted to make sure that kids, no matter their faith background, had a firm foundation of faith in Christ. We believed that repetition would write these truths on their young hearts. Our prayer would be on the day they encountered Jesus they would understand the gift He was offering.

INVITATION CARDS

This series of questions will be used at the end of each lesson. You may want to copy this card onto card stock and laminate it. Then keep this card with your supplies to be used each week. During Kids Club we never give a formal invitation; however, we always leave the children with the knowledge on how they can know Christ as Their Savior. We believe that the parents (believers or nonbelievers) should play an active role in leading their children through this important decision. Hopefully, for the parent who chooses not to follow Christ, they will hear the gospel through the mouth of their children as they question and learn about Jesus. Ultimately if the fathers come to know Christ then the possibility is there for the whole household to be saved. We also trust the Holy Spirit to keep those who have committed to follow Christ.

- 1. Who is God? (creator, He made us, Jesus's Father)
- 2. Where does God live? (In heaven)
- 3. What keeps us from going to heaven? (sin)
- **4.** What is sin? (bad things, disobedient, don't do what God wants us to do)
- 5. <u>Did God make a way for us to get</u> to <u>Heaven</u>? (yes, Jesus)
- **6.** Who is Jesus? (God's son)
- 7. What is so important about Jesus? (he died for us and took away our sin)
- 8. If Jesus died for us and took away our sin, then does everyone get to go to heaven? (No)
- **9.** So who gets to go? (Only those who believe in Jesus Christ, and that He died for them)
- 10.Do you believe that? Then the Bible says, that you are a child of God if you believe, you will have eternal life, you will get to live with God in heaven.
