The American Friends of Lafayette is an historical and patriotic society dedicated to the memory of Major General Gilbert Motier, Marquis de Lafayette and to the study of his life and times in America and France.

HISTORY

The Society was founded by Stuart Wells Jackson, a leading Lafayette collector, who enlisted the valuable support of Judge Walter P. Gardner, also a possessor of an important Lafayette collection. With eleven other enthusiastic admirers of General the Marquis de Lafayette, they formed The American Friends of Lafayette on May 20, 1932 at Lafayette College, Easton, Pennsylvania. This distinguished institution is the depository of The American Friends of Lafayette historical documents and memorabilia. It consists of more than 2,000 catalogued itemsbooks, pamphlets, articles, manuscripts, engravings, prints, and scores of other memorabilia.



Greetings,

On behalf of the American Friends of Lafayette, I thank you for your support of our Bicentennial Farewell Tour celebration. The AFL, founded in 1932, has as its principal purpose educating the public about the life and career of Lafayette; emphasizing his critically supportive role in the American Revolution; his human rights advocacy, including a 50-year career in the anti-slavery camp; and his centrality as a symbol of Franco-American friendship from 1777 to today.

The Bicentennial is a unique opportunity to educate the public about Lafayette's significance as well as the importance of the Farewell Tour itself. One contemporary statesman, Edward Everett, called it "an event, taken in all its parts, unparalleled in the history of man." Yet, today, Americans are, by and large, unaware of it.

We hope to increase awareness of the Farewell Tour, and Lafayette's life and legacy, by conducting commemorative events in the 24 states that Lafayette visited in 1824 and 1825. The AFL is producing eight virtual travelogues recounting Lafayette's visits to four of these states: Virginia, North Carolina, New Hampshire, and New York.

Today, we are launching the New York City Farewell Tour travelogue. We hope that it and the other travelogues will bring to life the pageantry of the Farewell Tour, when millions of Americans came to see the "Nation's Guest."

Another highlight of our Bicentennial educational events will be an all-day symposium (in-person and live-streamed) hosted by Fairfield University on September 7, 2024. We are very grateful to Fairfield's President, Dr. Mark Nemec, Dr. Philip Eliasoph, and their fantastic staff for helping the AFL produce this nationally important educational conference.

With your help, we will make the Bicentennial of Lafayette's return to America, kicking off in August 2024, a blockbuster event that re-captures the nation's attention just as Lafayette did in 1824!

AFL PROJECTS

- Annual Meeting Held in June at a site associated with Lafayette. Scholarly presentations, tours of nearby places of interest, and a banquet with a speaker.
- Yorktown Day The AFL is one of 13 associations that sponsor the Yorktown Celebration on October 19 each year, commemorating the Allied American and French troops' victory over British General Cornwallis on October 19, 1781. The AFL will be the lead sponsor in 2024.
- Lafayette Day, VA Annual celebration of Lafayette on March 14 in the rotunda of the State Capitol in front of the magnificent Houdon statue of Washington and surrounded by the Houdon bust of Lafayette and the busts of the US Presidents born in Virginia.
- Erected statues of Lafayette (2018) and Rochambeau (2021) in Yorktown.
- Published Gazette of the AFL annually since February 1942.
- Delivered speeches, round tables, and gatherings around the country to teach about our Franco-American Friendship.
- Provided inspiration and initial support for the Lafayette Trail.
- Established an archive of more than 2,000 cataloged items books, pamphlets, articles, manuscripts, engravings, prints, and scores of other memorabilia for which Lafayette College serves as custodian.
- Participated in the annual July 4th ceremony at Picpus Cemetery in Paris every year since 1946.
- Produced a set of six informational panels detailing the life and importance of Lafayette as a hero of the American Revolutionary War, abolitionaist and proto-feminist. Several sets of panels are on loan and continue to be made available to museums and educational sites.
- Produced virtual travelogues telling the stories of Lafayette's Farewell Tour visits to New York, New Hampshire, North Carolina, and Virginia.
