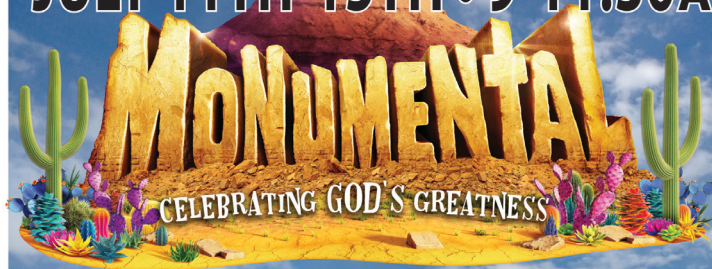

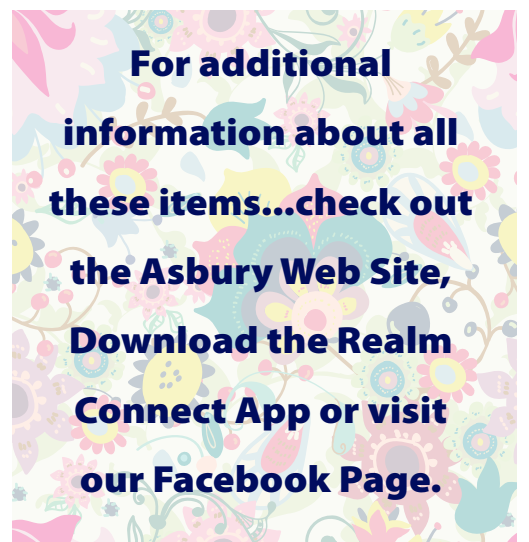

GROCERY RELIEF LIST FOR MAY


