PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday, May 24h -- Pentecost Sunday: Almighty God, we remember on Pentecost that You sent Your Holy Spirit upon the first followers of our Lord Jesus and filled them to overflowing. We would ask that You would do the same for us, here at Asbury Church. Fill us again, oh God! We are in deep need of Your indwelling Presence in us. Take away our dryness and rot. Remove from us our lethargy and apathy for the spiritual things of Christ. Fill us with the true River of Life that can only come from You! We ask this in the Name Above All Names, Jesus Christ our Lord, Amen.

Monday, May 25th: Prayerfully read/listen to Luke 24:45-49 with Acts 1:12-15. Based on these Scriptures, what were the primary activities of the followers of Jesus in those days as they waited (note the number of people gathered – v. 15)? Do you think these actions affected the coming of the Spirit? In other words – what if they all just scattered throughout Jerusalem, stayed apart from one another, and sat around doing nothing? How important was it that the Body remained together and in one accord? What does this tell us?

Tuesday, May 26th: Prayerfully read/listen to Acts 2:1-4,6,11, and 41 (or vv. 1-41 if you have time). Note that, when they gathered for the 10 days between the Ascension and Pentecost, there were 120 people (Acts 1:15). By the end of the day on Pentecost, the Lord, “add that day about three thousand souls.” (2:41 NASB). What would you have been thinking if you were one of the original 120? Would you have welcomed all of that change? What would we do if Asbury suddenly had an influx of 3,000 people? How can we rely on the Holy Spirit so that we are obedient to whatever changes God wants to bring into our lives, whether personally, in our families or work, in our church, or in other areas?

Wednesday, May 27th: Prayerfully read/listen to Acts 2:42-46. Note specifically how often the people were taking the actions that are listed in these verses: sometimes? Occasionally? Once in a while? Underline or circle what the Scriptures say about these moments. What does this tell you about how the Holy Spirit was moving among the people at that time. Do you think that was a sort of, “one and done” experience; that it was unique to that time and place in the life of the church? Why or why not? Is it possible for the Holy Spirit to move among the people of Asbury in a similarly profound way? What might happen?

Thursday, May 28th: Prayerfully read/listen to Ephesians 5:18 – why are we told to be filled (imperative) with the Spirit and not be filled with wine and alcohol? Why does Paul use this comparison? Have you ever been filled with alcohol, or been around someone who has? What was that like? How did the alcohol affect you or that person? Based on what you know about inebriation, why is being filled with the Holy Spirit a similar experience – but so much better?!

Friday, May 29th: Prayerfully read/listen to Ephesians 1:3-14. Write down every blessing Paul lists in this passage that belongs to us as a result of our belonging to Christ Jesus through the presence of the Holy Spirit. Was there anything new to you that you did not already know about? What does Paul say specifically about the Holy Spirit in these verses? What is astonishing to you about what Paul reveals to us in this passage? Take some time to pray through these verses!

Saturday, May 30th: Review each of these Scriptures, questions, and prayers that you have worked through this week. Which one, or which theme, resonated with you? Pray through these things again as the Spirit leads you!
