PRAYER AT ASBURY

At Asbury Church we believe what Colossians 4:2 teaches, "Devote yourselves to prayer with an alert mind and a thankful heart" (NLT). Just outside of the Sanctuary doors there is a prayer wall. Since the 1700s people have been putting written prayers in the cracks of the Western Wall in Jerusalem. The idea was simple: Leave a Prayer, Take a Prayer. When we created the prayer wall at Asbury Church we had the same idea! Leave the prayers of your heart at the wall. Take someone else's prayer and pray over that. When you are done, simply discard it knowing that God has heard the prayer! There is no need to return it, unless you feel like it needs more prayer! Added Bonus, we left a Bible there that you can highlight and add an encouraging note to your favorite verse. Consider it a guest book of Bible Verses!
