#### WOMEN'S THURSDAY MORNING BIBLE STUDY HAS BEGUN

Our next study of scripture has begun, but there is still time to join. Thursdays at 9:30am -- Epic of Eden Bible Study. This is a 12-week study and will end on April 18th.

Description: "Dr. Sandra Richter clearly and powerfully communicates a history of God's redeeming grace, weaving together a story that runs from the Eden of the Garden to the garden of the New Jerusalem. Through text and video teaching, Dr. Richter uses this 12-week study to bring a new dimension to the history of the ancient Near East, orienting a study group in time, geography, culture, redemption, and relevance to today — all without diminishing her reader's faith or dumbing down the scripture.



# PRAYER GUIDE

- **Sunday January 21th:** Lord God, from the beginning of time, You have called Your people out from wherever they lived to not only follow You, but to serve others in Your Name. In our day, You are calling us to do the same: to serve others in love in every way through the power of Jesus, the Lord and Savior of the world. Help us to be as brave as the saints we look up to. For the glory of Jesus' Name, Amen.
- Monday January 22nd: Prayerfully read or listen to Luke 19:1-5. According to these verses, how did Jesus and Zaccheus "connect?" Would you say this meeting between Jesus and Zaccheus was a "coincidence?" Did Jesus orchestrate it? Did Zaccheus? How did this meeting take place, exactly? Looking back...how did you and the Lord "connect" in the beginning?
- **Tuesday January 23rd:** Prayerfully read or listen to Luke 19:1-10. After Jesus and Zaccheus meet, what happened? What is the evidence that Jesus changed Zaccheus' life? Was there evidence in right away that Jesus had come into your life, or was it more like a sunrise or flower blooming – did it take some time before the evidence was revealed?
- Wednesday January 24th: FASTING DAY! Pray and fast as you are able (in whatever way is appropriate for you, keeping in mind a Biblical Fast is fasting from some/all foods). Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 5:13-6:1a. What do you think it means to "be taken forward to maturity" or "press on to maturity" in Christ? If you can, look up the word "maturity" in the Greek. What does the author want the readers of this letter to do? Can you describe a "mature Christian?"
- Thursday January 25th: Prayerfully read or listen to Mark 10:42-45. What comparison is Jesus making in these verses? What contrast is He making for His followers? Who are we to be like, and whom are we to not be like? In what ways are Christians today tempted to follow the wrong types of people? Spend some time praying about this, for yourself and Asbury's leaders.
- Friday January 26th: Prayerfully read or listen to Mark 10:45. The verb "serve" in Greek means "caring for the needs of others in a practical way." What is the difference between a true believer doing this, and an unbeliever doing the exact same work? See also John 15:1-11.
- Saturday January 27th: Take time to look over all the passages of Scripture we have studied and prayed over this week, as well as the things you have learned. Be still, and listen to what the Lord would tell you, personally, today.
