

### PRAYER

- **Sunday, April 14th:** Great King, You astonish us! That You would leave Your heavenly throne to not only come to live amongst us, but to die on a cross; for us? And yet after You rose from the dead, You continued to live with Your disciples, not in Kingly glory, but as You always did, eating, drinking, teaching, and showing them (and us) the way of loving servanthood. Help us to live out this life each day. Amen.
- Monday, April 15th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 21:1-14, with John 20:30-31. Why do you think the apostle John included this particular story in his Gospel (as opposed to other resurrection stories that other Gospel writers included in theirs)?
- Tuesday, April 16th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 21:9-14. What might Peter have thought about when he saw the charcoal fire (see John 18:18,25-27)? Also consider his reaction when he realized it was the Lord on the beach (John 21:7). What do you learn from all of this?
- **Wednesday, April 17th:** NO FASTING! This is week we continue to CELEBRATE that Jesus is RISEN FROM THE DEAD! There is no reason to fast as we continue to rejoice that our Lord is alive forevermore! Take some time today to pray and give thanks to God!
- Thursday, April 18th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 21:12-14. Why do you think Jesus wanted to have breakfast with His disciples at this point? Besides restoring Peter (see 21:15-17), would any of the others need restoration? Why or why not?
- Friday, April 19th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 21:12. What would it be like if Jesus asked you to breakfast today? What would the two of you talk about? What is on your mind? What is on His? Pray about this, and give Him time to respond.
- Saturday, April 20th: Take time to look over all the passages of Scripture we have studied and prayed over this week, as well as the things you have learned. Be still, and listen to what the Lord would tell you, personally, today.
