
Join us for a prayer time on Tuesdays at 6pm in the Fireside Room. Let's come together to stand ready, hear God's call, and boldly respond in faith.

• BOOK OF DANIEL STUDY: Framework of Prophecy: The book of Daniel serves as God's blueprint for prophecy by outlining kingdoms that followed Babylon and current world kingdoms preceding the end-times, includes the "famous" 70 weeks of Daniel prophecy and detailed descriptions of the 400 year inter-testament period. 400 years before Christ, Daniel prophesied the coming Messiah; Sir R. Anderson said, "To the day." A captive in a permissive and pagan Babylonian society, yet Daniel never compromised his values, even when threatened with death. Class starts September 10th for 10 weeks and will meet Wednesday mornings 10-11:30am and Wednesday evenings at 6-7:30pm in Room D106 led by Linda Stephen. The study book is "The Book of Daniel, the Smart Guide to the Bible" by Duck and Richards. Cost of the book is about \$8. Have questions or would you like to sign up for this class? "JESUS REVEALED IN THE END TIMES" BOOK BY DR. ROBERT JEFFRES

This women's study will focus on Jesus as the Messiah, as the Prophet, as the Lamb, as the Conqueror, as the King, as the Judge, as the Lord, and as our Friend. Most books about the end times focus on the events rather than the One who is revealed in those events. We will study the end times through the lens of Jesus Christ. - Sunday, September 14th: Lord God, thank You for being the Good Shepherd. You are the One Who calls my name. I hear Your voice and know I can follow You, because You are trustworthy. Thank You for leading me to good places, even though sometimes to get there, You have to lead me through dark valleys. Help me to always keep my eyes on You, and my ears attentive to only Your voice. Surely goodness and mercy will follow me all the days of my life, Amen.
- Monday, September 15th: Prayerfully read or listen to Psalm 23. Too often, the only time we refer to this psalm is at a funeral. Why do you suppose that is? Carefully review this psalm, and look at all the ways the Lord cares for you, noting especially the personal pronouns. How could you re-word this psalm so that it fits more directly with your life (for example, rather than "He leads me beside still waters..." what would be more specific to your situation? Where has He led you that is peaceful and calm?)?
- Tuesday, September 16th: Prayerfully read or listen to Ezekiel 34:1-10. Who is God angry with? What does He accuse them of? If this prophecy was coming to the church today (this is not aimed at governments), would it still be accurate? Who would it be aimed at today?
- Wednesday, September 17th: Prayerfully read or listen to Ezekiel 34:11-31. What does Ezekiel say God will do for His people? What specifically does He promise to do?
- Thursday, September 18th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 10:1-10. Now that you have read the key Old Testament "Shepherd" passages, when Jesus declared that HE is "the Good Shepherd," does this metaphor make more sense? What does Jesus promise? How does this connect with the Ezekiel passage? Do you think the people understood the reference?
- Friday, September 19th: Prayerfully read or listen to John 10:10. What does Jesus say about Himself vs. the enemy? How widely are the two of them contrasted? Do you believe for yourself that Jesus came to give you abundant life? How do you think Jesus would describe "abundant life?" How would you define and describe "abundant life?"
- Saturday, September 20th: Review each of these Scriptures, topics, and questions that you have worked through this week. How does all of this resonate with you? Pray through these things as the Spirit leads you!
