

"JESUS REVEALED IN THE END TIMES" BOOK BY DR. ROBERT JEFFRES

This women's study will focus on Jesus as the Messiah, as the Prophet, as the Lamb, as the Conqueror, as the King, as the Judge, as the Lord, and as our Friend. Most books about the end times focus on the events rather than the One who is revealed in those events. Sunday, October 26th: Almighty Father, You have created each person and placed us where You would have us. Too often Lord, we think we don't have an impact on anyone, and that we don't make any difference. Forgive us for believing this lie! The truth is – each one of us makes an impact; the question is whether or not we affect people for Your Kingdom! Come Holy Spirit and fill us so fully that we draw those around us closer to Jesus, and expand Your Kingdom each day. In Jesus' Name, Amen.

Monday, October 27th: Prayerfully read or listen to Matthew 5:13. Can you imagine using "saltless" salt? Does that even make any sense to you? What do you think is Jesus' point with this metaphor – and don't overthink this! There are many reasons to use salt, but if it doesn't have its basic quality, then what good is it? Jesus answers this question, and draws the parallel to His followers. How does this apply to you?

Tuesday, October 28th: Prayerfully read or listen to Matthew 5:14-15. Based on this analogy, do you think the Lord wants His followers to be seen and noticed by the world? Why or why not? When is it appropriate to be "seen" as a Christian and when is it not? Do you think it is worth losing your job over? Losing your home over? Losing friends or position over? Losing your life over? How do you know when to make such decisions?

Wednesday, October 29th: Prayerfully read or listen to Matthew 5:16 and Matthew 6:3. How do you reconcile Jesus' admonition in Mt. 5:16 to let others see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven, with Mt. 6:3, that when you give alms, you should do it so secretively, you should barely even acknowledge it to yourself? Why does He seem to say two different things?

Thursday, October 30th: Prayerfully re-read Matthew 5:13-16. This is a passage about having influence in the world, and upon those around you. We all influence those around us, just as they influence us. How can we be sure we are influencing those around us for Christ? Are there sure-fire ways? Take some time to pray and ask the Lord what HE would have you do to draw those in your life to Christ.

Friday, October 31st: All Hallows Eve: Lord God, You are the Giver of Life, and the source of all eternal Hope. We thank You that in Christ Jesus, we have nothing to fear. We pray that You will banish all darkness, fear, and evil from our lives and from the lives of those we love. We look forward to that coming Day when the enemy will be cast away forever and ever! Help us to keep our eyes on Jesus, today and always, Amen.

Saturday, November 1st: All Saints Day: Thank You Heavenly Father for the many people in my life who have shown me how to be a faithful follower of the Lord Jesus. Some of these people were known to me, and some I have known only through stories, books, or movies and TV. I can't wait to see them face to face when You bring me into Your Kingdom! Help me to be such a person to others Lord. For the glory of Jesus' Name I pray, Amen.
