The Story continues on Wednesday, January 14th at 6:30pm in the Sanctuary. Join Pastor Rick for great conversations with some very special people.



REASONS TO STUDY THE BOOK OF REVELATION

Revelation is about JESUS! Revelation reveals God's plan for the future is to glorify His Son!! Revelation teaches us the victory and control of God, especially in these uncertain times. Amos 3:7 says God always tells His prophets first as seen in the est. 2000 out of 3000 already fulfilled prophecies. Only our Bible has verifiable fulfilled prophecies! Revelation is the ONLY book of the Bible that promises blessings for those that read and listen (Rev. 1:3). Revelation gives us an urgent concern for those that don't know Jesus as Savior. In Matt.24:42-44 and Luke 12:35-40, Jesus told us to "watch and be ready".

If His prophecy is being fulfilled, wouldn't you want to know and "be ready"? Come to be blessed and decide for yourself! The book used for this class will be "Standing on the edge of Eternity" by G. Hamrick and costs \$9.

PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday January 11th: Almighty God, it is beyond our comprehension that we are able to enter into Your Throne Room, which is indeed the Holy Place, Your very Presence, all because of the blood of Jesus. He Himself has opened for us this new and living way through the sacrifice of His body, and He is our Great High Priest! We can now draw near to You, and there is no reason at all for us to shrink away. Help us oh Lord to do this very thing – to draw near to You with the full assurance of faith, all because of Jesus, in Whose Name we pray, Amen.

Monday, January 12th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 10:19-25. This passage begins with the word "Therefore." This means, it is important to see what comes before it (to see why the "therefore" is there for). Read Chapter 10:1-18 to familiarize yourself with the theme and points that the author of the letter is making (if you have time, go back even further). What subjects and ideas are highlighted in Chapter 10? What does the author want us to know? Are there any points that specifically stand out to you? How do verses 19-25 fit with what comes before?

Tuesday, January 13th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 10:19-22. Based on what the author states in Ch. 10:1-21, what are the reasons we have for being able to "draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings?" List as many as you can.

Wednesday, January 14th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 10:23. In this verse, we are called to "hold unswervingly to the hope we profess..." The Greek word means to "hold fast; keep, hold firmly, possess." Can you remember times either in your life when you have had to do this? What were the circumstances? Take some time in prayer as you remember those events before the Lord, and remember His faithfulness in your life.

Thursday, January 15th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 10:24. What do you think is the key word in this verse? Hint – it's the main verb; the main action of the sentence. Why is this so important in the Body of Christ? What happens if/when we do not do this for one another? Do you think we do this at Asbury? How could we do this better?

Friday, January 16th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 10:24-25. How do these verses work together? While some people literally cannot physically be in church due to health reasons, why is it important to "not give up meeting together?" Why do we need to physically be in the same space together as we worship, fellowship, share in Communion, etc.? How does physically being together on a regular, ongoing basis build up the Body of Christ? How can we be more intentional about including our Homebound?

Saturday, January 17th: Review each of these Scriptures, questions, and prayers that you have worked through this week. Which one, or which theme, resonated with you? Pray through these things again as the Spirit leads you!
