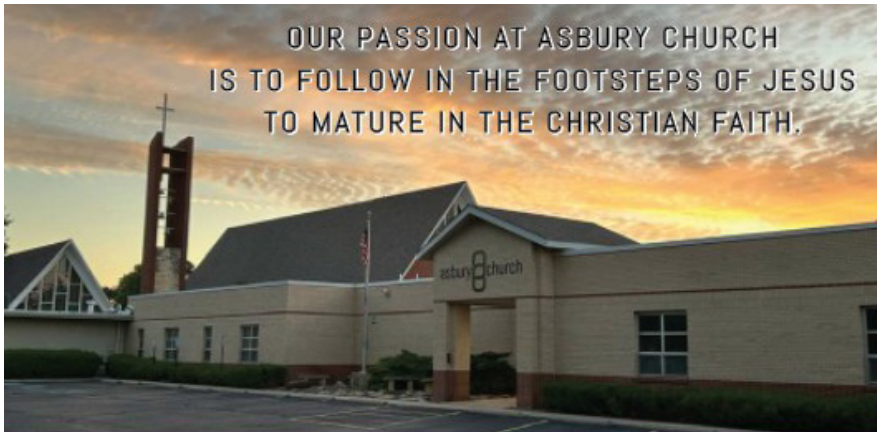

PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday, January 4th: Lord God, You alone are the Creator of all things. You are the Ancient of Days. The Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. Another year is upon us and we have no idea what is to come, but You do. You know all things, Lord, and all things are in Your hands. You are making all things new! We are grateful You have redeemed, and are redeeming, even us. Help us to look ahead with hope and joy, because You are always with us. In the Name of the One Who died, rose again, and reigns forever, Amen.

Monday, January 5th: Prayerfully read or listen to Isaiah 43:18-19. This passage is part of a larger section in Isaiah where the prophet is encouraging the people of Israel. If you have time, read from Isaiah 40 to this passage. What is the general thrust of this portion of Isaiah? What is the Lord telling His people? Within all of this, what is important about 43:18-19? What "former things" do you think the people are to "forget" and not dwell on? In your life in particular, are there "former things" that the Lord would have you to "forget"? Why does He want you to do so?

Tuesday, January 6th -- Epiphany: Prayerfully read or listen to Isaiah 43:18-19. Why is it important to remember some things and to forget other ones? In your life, what are important things for you to remember each year? How do you mark those occasions? This passage, however, indicates that the people were doing this very thing – "remembering" – the wrong things! Are there things in your life that you might be "remembering" in all the wrong ways? How can you find ways to let them go, once and for all? How can this be the year you are FREE from them? How can being free from such things give you the ability to see what God is doing in your midst?

Wednesday, January 7th: Prayerfully read or listen to 2 Corinthians 5:17. Paul similarly talks about how the old is gone, and the new has come. In reflecting back on your life before Christ, and now looking at your life IN Christ – what of the "old life" has gone away? What is "new" that has come? Are there still parts of your "old" life that intrude on your "new" life? Why is that so? Spend some time in prayer and ask the Lord to help you discern what might be a couple of things you can do by the power of the Holy Spirit to move away/ walk away from those old ways. Ask Him to show you very specifically what you need to do. Then ask Him to help you to be obedient and to follow through!

Thursday, January 8th: Prayerfully read or listen to Revelation 21:5. What is the amazing difference between the Lord saying, "I am making everything new," instead of "I am making new things?" When you consider the world, some of the events that have transpired even in the past few years, let alone in our lifetimes, how does this passage give you hope in Christ? Spend time today praying for our national leaders in light of this passage.

Friday, January 9th: Prayerfully read or listen to Lamentations 3:22-24. Asbury Church will have a lot of "new" in 2026! Thankfully, the Lord does not leave us alone to sort out our future. His faithfulness is great, and His compassions never fail. Take time today to give God thanks for all He has done for Asbury in the past, and pray fervently for our Board as they work through the process with our Conference Superintendent to bring on Asbury's next Senior Pastor.

Saturday, January 10th: Review each of these Scriptures, questions, and prayers that you have worked through this week. Which one, or which theme, resonated with you? Pray through these things again as the Spirit leads you!

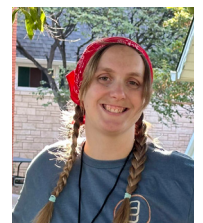
