PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday, February 1st (Transition Sunday for Asbury): Lord God, our times are in Your hands. You are the One Who established Asbury Church well over 100 years ago. You have given us faithful pastors to lead your people all this way, and we are so grateful. Thank You for Pastor Rick and Mary Lou, who have helped us to keep our eyes on Jesus through very turbulent waters these past 10 1/2 years. Thank You for their steadfast courage and leadership in these times. In turn Lord, we ask for a double-portion of Your Spirit to come upon Pastor Clint and Rebecca as they step forward and serve You now. May their eyes be upon You alone. May they too, be strong and courageous. May Your Word be upon their lips and upon their hearts, meditating upon it day by day. Fill them Holy Spirit and guide them in all the decisions they must make, and may we willingly follow as Pastor Clint leads us in the path of Christ, in Whose Name we pray, Amen.

Monday, February 2nd: Prayerfully read or listen to Philippians 1:3-6 (if you have time, review 1:1-11). Where was Paul when he wrote this letter, and how do you think he felt about the Philippian church? Think about other churches or Bible Study groups, or other Christians you may have known over the years. Can you say these words about them? Take some time to pray over these people, groups or Churches today.

Tuesday, February 3rd: Prayerfully read or listen to Philippians 1:3-6. Think back over the past 10+ years of Asbury's time, and Pastor Rick's and Mary Lou's leadership. What stands out to you during their time with us? What has changed about Asbury? Spend some time praying for Asbury today, and especially pray for them as they transition into a new phase of life.

Wednesday, February 4th: Prayerfully read or listen to 2 Timothy 2:1-2. This letter was most likely Paul's last letter, written shortly before his execution. In this passage, what is he most concerned about? In the end, what are you most concerned about? What matters most to you? Can you put it down in 1-3 sentences? In our English Bibles, Paul's utmost concern comes down to one short sentence, and one longer one. See if you can summarize your deepest concerns in the same way, and pray about these matters.

Thursday, February 5th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 12:1-3. If you had to pick out the key phrase in this passage, what would it be (hint: there are several, so there is no wrong answer!)? Why did you pick that phrase? If you think of that phrase in light of the other passages we have looked at this week, does it fit in, or would you pick another phrase? If you held these verses up next to Asbury Church, do you think we are matching them well, or are we getting caught up in a sin/sins that is/are entangling us? Are we keeping our eyes on Jesus, or are we losing our focus? Do we consider Him, or do we grow weary? As you consider this passage, pray about our weak areas, and ask the Lord to strengthen us as a church!

Friday, February 6th: Prayerfully read or listen to Hebrews 12:1-3. Take time today and pray this passage carefully for Pastor Clint, Rebecca, and their family!

Saturday, February 7th: Review each of these Scriptures, questions, and prayers that you have worked through this week. Which one, or which theme, resonated with you? Pray through these things again as the Spirit leads you!
