• BOOK OF DANIEL STUDY: Framework of Prophecy: The book of Daniel serves as God's blueprint for prophecy by outlining kingdoms that followed Babylon and current world kingdoms preceding the end-times, includes the "famous" 70 weeks of Daniel prophecy and detailed descriptions of the 400 year inter-testament period. 400 years before Christ, Daniel prophesied the coming Messiah; Sir R. Anderson said, "To the day." A captive in a permissive and pagan Babylonian society, yet Daniel never compromised his values, even when threatened with death. Class starts September 10th for 10 weeks and will meet Wednesday mornings 10-11:30am and Wednesday evenings at 6-7:30pm in Room D106 led by Linda Stephen. The study book is "The Book of Daniel, the Smart Guide to the Bible" by Duck and Richards. Cost of the book is about \$8. Have guestions or would you like to sign up for this class? - Sunday, August 24th: Almighty God, we thank You so much for those who have taught us, led us, mentored us, and modeled the way of Christ for us. Whether these are saints who have lived out their daily lives before us, or perhaps we have read about their lives in books, or learned about them in a movie, we are grateful. They have helped us understand what it means to be like Jesus. Now grant us, oh God, the power of Your Spirit to do the same for those around us, and those who come after us, for the sake of Christ Jesus our Lord, Amen.
- Monday, August 25th: Prayerfully read or listen to 1 Tim 1:18-19. Also note 1 Tim 1:2a. How does Paul refer to Timothy in this letter? Why does Paul refer to Timothy this way? If you don't know, there may be information at the start of the letter, or do some research with a Bible app or dictionary. Who do you consider to be your spiritual "parent(s)" in the faith? What reasons do you give for this? Take some time today and give God thanks for this person/these people. If it is appropriate, send a note or email and say thank you for their presence in your life!
- **Tuesday, August 26th:** Prayerfully read or listen to 1 Tim 4:9-14. It is clear from this passage that Timothy is a fairly young pastor in Ephesus, yet Paul is encouraging him to not be intimidated in his position. What are some specific things Paul is instructing him in? Have you ever sat under a young pastor or teacher? What did you think? Were you able to pray for that person (either openly, or at least in your time with the Lord)? Even in the church, what are we more often apt to do, rather than pray? Has this been your experience? How can we turn this around?
- **Wednesday, August 27th:** Prayerfully read or listen to 1 Tim 4:1-14. Consider the qualities Paul highlights to Timothy. How can you exhibit such qualities and be an example of godliness to others, regardless of your age? Ask the Lord for the strength and power of the Spirit to walk faithfully with Him, so that others will see such qualities in you.
- Thursday, August 28th: Prayerfully read or listen to 1 Tim 6:11-14. Again, Paul gives a list of qualities to Timothy. How is this section of the letter different — or similar to — the one in chapter 4? If you were Timothy and you were receiving this letter from Paul, do you think you would feel encouraged and strong, or would you feel even more intimidated?
- Friday, August 29th: Take the time to read all of 1 Timothy, and imagine Paul is writing this letter to you personally. What would he change in it to personalize it? What would stay the same? Use some imagination and think this through. What would Paul say to you in his letter that would both encourage but also challenge you? Consider the ways the Lord could use such an exercise to help you grow in your faith!
- Saturday, August 30th: Review each of these Scriptures, topics, and questions that you have worked through this week. How does all of this resonate with you? Pray through these things as the Spirit leads you!
