Our new Senior Pastor Clint McBroom wants to meet you!






LENTEN STUDY BEGINS 2/25

PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday, February 15th: Lord God, thank you for all Your kindnesses towards us. You pour out so many blessings upon us each day! You have faithfully watched over us day after day, year after year, and led us through every "high and stormy gale." Lord, help us to continue to keep our eyes fixed upon You. There are times when the way ahead looks bright and sunny, and times when it looks dark and scary. Lord God, help us not to look so much at our circumstances, but rather to look to You. For the sake of Christ we ask this, Amen.

Monday, February 16th: Prayerfully read or listen to Joshua 24:1-13. In this passage, Joshua reviews Israel's history, from its very beginning when God called Abram from the land of Ur. How did your family begin – where do you consider it started? Was it when you and your spouse married, or earlier? What is your family's story? How did the Lord's hand guide your family in the past? How does Asbury Church fit into your family's story, and how does your family fit into Asbury's story?

Tuesday, February 17th: Prayerfully read or listen to Joshua 24:14. What are the two words that this verse begins with and why are they important? In the same way, how are the past two Sundays similar in the life of Asbury? What are we as Asburians called to do at this point? When have you had other points in your life like this one? Were such moments difficult or easy? What was happening in your life that such a moment came to pass? When did such moments occur at Asbury?

Wednesday, February 18th: ASH WEDNESDAY: Today is the beginning of Lent. This is a season of fasting for many people. Traditionally, it is a time to fast (refrain from consuming) either one or more meals in a week, or certain foods during this period of time. However, fasting doesn't have to be confined to food. Other options include fasting from Social Media, television, sleep (getting up an hour earlier to spend more time with the Lord), or something else. We encourage you to consider what "gets in the way" of your relationship with the Lord, and fast from that during this season, and then seek to strengthen your love for Him.

Thursday, February 19th: Prayerfully read or listen to Joshua 24:14-27. Today, look especially at what this passage says about who the Lord is and what He has done, and why we are to fear Him. Why is it important for us to remember these things about the Lord God? Why was Joshua so firm about telling the people exactly what would happen if they turned away from the Lord God? Why does God value obedience and faithfulness to Him?

Friday, February 20th: Prayerfully read or listen to Joshua 24:14-27. There may be lots of things we believe the Lord wants to do in and through us at Asbury, but above all, according to this passage, what does God want most of all (see especially v. 14, 15, 24; see also John 15:9-10)? What do you think this looks like for us at Asbury? What do you think we need to change at Asbury to be more in line with what the Lord is talking about here in these verses?

Saturday, February 21st: Review each of these Scriptures, questions, and prayers that you have worked through this week. Which one, or which theme, resonated with you? Pray through these things again as the Spirit leads you!
