### THE PRAY-GROUND:



Give hope to women in Wichita facing unexpected pregnancies. Fill a bottle with change, cash, or checks and return it on Father's Day.






## VBS IS COMING SOON: CAN YOU HELP!

How are you responding? Are you responding? Why or Why Not? Be prepared to share your experiences!



# ASBURY PRAYER GUIDE

- **Sunday, June 11th** Hebrews 10:24 & 25 reminds us, "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." With this in mind, let us rejoice at the freedom we have to gather and worship God together.
- Monday, June 12th Read Genesis 3:1-3. What are some ways other voices have been deceiving you, lately? What is your response? Do you twist God's words the way Eve did by imposing stricter rules on yourself? God only told Adam and Eve not to eat the fruit from the tree of good & evil. He never said they couldn't touch it. (Genesis 2:17)
- **Tuesday, June 13th** Read Genesis 3:1-5. Continue to ask God to open your eyes to the things you think you know about Him but may need scriptural correction. Ask Him for the desire to know His truth and where to find that truth in His Word.
- **Wednesday, June 14th, Fasting Day** Pastor Rick's sermon series continues to focus on hungering and thirsting for God and then allowing Him to satisfy your soul. Read Matthew 5:6 and use it as a quick prayer throughout the day.
- **Thursday, June 15th** Read Genesis 3:6-9. Compare this to Psalm 139:7-12. Is there anywhere to hide from God? How does the wisdom of the world deceive us into thinking that we can hide from God? Why do we try to hide from Him when He alone can satisfy?
- **Friday, June 16th** Read Genesis 3:8-13. Notice how Adam and Eve try to shift blame on each other and the serpent. Ask God to show you things you are not taking responsibility for. If this leads to a time of repentance before the Lord be sure to receive His forgiveness before you end your time with Him.
- **Saturday, June 17th** Read Genesis 3:14-24. Adam and Eve's punishment is severe. They are banished from the presence of God. How does Jesus change this for us as believers in Him? Read Romans 5:12-19 for clarification.
